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Once a year during a special time called Open Enrollment you can choose to stay with your current plan or pick a new one. Each person listed below can make a choice when Open Enrollment begins.

You do not have to make a change if you are happy with your current plan(s).

Open Enrollment begins for each person listed above on 1/1/0001. On that day you may choose a new plan for each person listed above. Your last date to change plans is 5/1/2023. Plans in your region are listed online and on the enclosed flyer.

You now have 3 ways to pick a new plan:

To enroll you will need the birth year, and Medicaid ID or the Gold Card number for each person listed on this letter.

Please note: As a Medically Needy (Share of Cost) recipient, your Medicaid plan enrollment will only be effective for the timeframes that you have Medicaid eligibility. Each time you gain eligibility, the plan you have selected will be your plan. If you want to change plans at a time other than during Open Enrollment, you may need a state-approved For Cause reason. Choosing a plan does not mean that you have Medicaid coverage. Be sure to keep all appointments and return information required by the Department of Children and Families or the Social Security Administration that relate to your eligibility.

Remember, if you are happy with your plan, you do not have to make a change.
